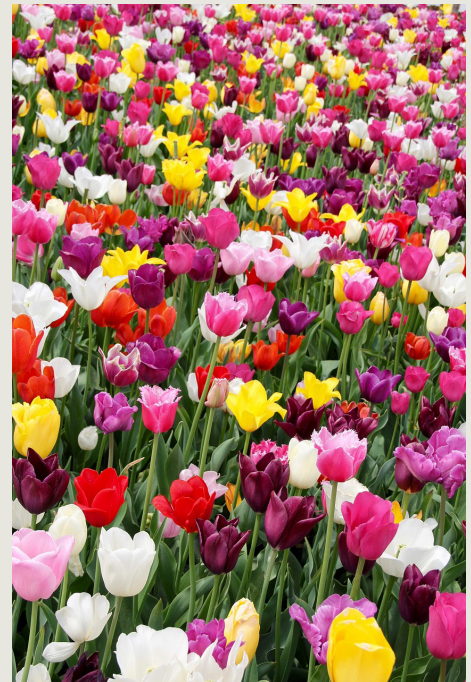

## The Hague



With its beach resort at Scheveningen and a historic centre, there's lots to enjoy in the Hague. The famous Mauritshuis museum is home to Vermeer's *Girl with a Pearl Earring* and the *Goldfinch* by Fabritius, and for a shortcut to seeing all the sights of the Netherlands, there's always Madurodam, with its range of 1:25 scale model replicas of famous Dutch landmarks and historic cities.

Home of Abel + Imray's Dutch Office, Delft is a beautiful town criss-crossed by canals lined with historic buildings and churches – a mini-Amsterdam! Also famous for the manufacturing of blueware and the painter Johannes Vermeer. Visit the home of famous Delft Blue pottery or the Johannes Vermeer Centrum, or just soak up the atmosphere and take a Delft Selfie #Delftie from one of the hundreds of bridges.

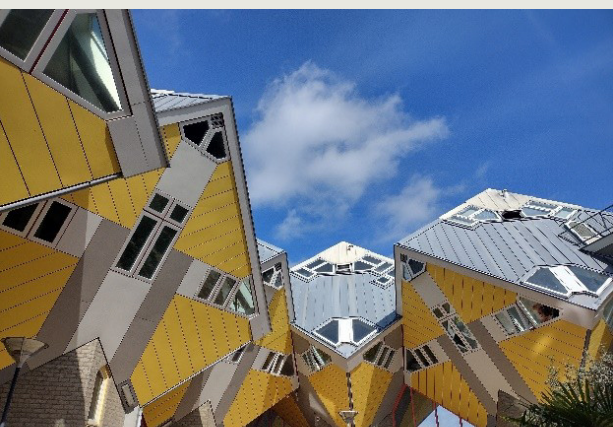

## Rotterdam



An exciting city filled with unusual architecture, Rotterdam is well worth a visit. There's so much to see, including the striking Erasmus bridge, iconic Kijk-Kubus museum house, the market hall, a historic harbour, the SS Rotterdam, legendary former flagship of the Holland America Line, and Blijdorp Zoo.

## Kinderdijk



If you want to see proper Dutch windmills, nothing beats the Kinderdijk UNESCO World Heritage site, with its 19 historic windmills stretched out across the landscape. To make the trip an adventure, take the water bus from Rotterdam.
